

## **Bristow & Sutor Parking Contract Win at Coventry City Council**

**January 2007:** Coventry City Council has appointed Bristow & Sutor Civil Enforcement Agents as one of two suppliers to recover unpaid Penalty Charge Notices. The Council became responsible for the enforcement of parking restrictions in April 2005 under the Road Traffic Act 1991 (as amended).

The contract is effective from 1 February 2007 until 31 January 2008.

Kash Dhadwar, Coventry City Council's Parking Manager said, "The Council has developed a parking enforcement theme called "Think B 4 U Park" to encourage drivers to do just that, consider all road and footway users such as other motorists, cyclists, pedestrians and public transport users when they park. This new arrangement of dealing with enforcement in the city, is part of a long term plan to improve road safety and increase traffic flow on Coventry's roads and the appearance of the city."
