

Bristow & Sutor Parking Contract Win at North Wiltshire District Council

August 2007: North Wiltshire District Council has appointed Bristow & Sutor Civil Enforcement Agents to recover unpaid **Penalty Charge Notices**. The Council became responsible for the enforcement of parking restrictions in 2007 under the Road Traffic Act 1991 (as amended).

The agreement is to run for a period of 2 years, commencing August 2007 or until the vesting day of the new unitary council within Wiltshire, whichever is sooner.
