

Leicester City Council implement Decriminalised Parking Enforcement

May 2007: Leicester City Council has appointed Bristow & Sutor for recovery services in respect of Penalty Charge Notices. The contract is deemed effective from January 2007 and will continue until December 2008.

Nigel Clarke, Parking Enforcement Team Leader at Leicester City Council said, "The Council took over the responsibility of enforcing parking regulations from Leicestershire police in January 2007. We wanted the transition to be as unproblematic as possible, with minimum disruption to the general public and our residents. The 14 year track record that Bristow & Sutor has with the council was just one of the reasons that we appointed them. The recent comprehensive tender and market evaluation conducted by the council's Revenues Department confirmed our decision.

Commenting on the win, Andy Rose, Managing Director of Bristow & Sutor said, "We are delighted with the decision. We value the relationship we have built with LCC over the past 14 years and look forward to supporting the Parking Services Team. Decriminalised Parking is being rolled out across the rest of the County and we look forward to supporting Leicester City Council as they set the example."
