

Bristow & Sutor Win Leicestershire County Parking Contract

April 2008: Leicestershire County Council has appointed Bristow & Sutor as one of two companies to provide bailiff services the collection of Penalty Charge Notices. The contract is for a period of 3 years effective from 1 May 2008 – 30 April 2011.

The evaluation of the tenders was completed jointly by officers of the Council, and ESPO (Eastern Shires Purchasing Organisation). ESPO is a local authority purchasing consortium operating throughout the Midlands and East Anglia. It is a non-profit making body owned and operated jointly by seven local authorities, whose key objective is to help its member authorities achieve optimum value for money when buying goods and services.

The contract award provides for Bristow & Sutor to support **all** of the Leicestershire Local Authorities for Civil Parking Enforcement. The contract also provides for appropriate Councils beyond Leicestershire to seek Bristow & Sutor's services.
