

Bristow & Sutor win Parking Contract at Wolverhampton City Council

August 2007: Wolverhampton City Council has appointed Bristow & Sutor Civil Enforcement Agents to collect unpaid Penalty Charge Notices, as part of their new Decriminalised Parking Enforcement (DPE) Scheme.
